

## **Judges Education Committee**

### **Scope:**

The purpose of the English Toy Spaniel Club of America (ETSCA) Judges Education Committee is to inform and educate conformation judges and prospective conformation judges of English Toy Spaniels on the breed, breed standard, and judging procedure for the English Toy Spaniel. The Judges Education Committee is responsible for creating, updating, and objectively presenting educational materials to aspiring, provisional, and approved judges. Such materials must be approved by Board, and shall be consistent with the approved Standard of the English Toy Spaniel, as well as Board-approved interpretations of the standard.

### **Objectives:**

The Judges Education Committee shall hold and support breed presentations across the United States in order to facilitate the breed education needs of judges. The Committee shall distribute breed education material to individuals who are in the application process to judge English Toy Spaniels. The Committee shall be responsible for supporting Ringside Mentoring, Breed Seminars, and Breed Workshops at Specialties, Supported Entries, and Judge Education Symposia.

### **Committee Membership:**

The Committee is comprised of a Chairperson and up to five additional members. The Chairperson is identified and confirmed by the Board. Additional members of the Committee will be identified by the Chairperson and will present their qualifications to the Board for serving on the committee. All identified members will be approved by the Board. All confirmed Committee members are urged to complete a minimum of one (1) two-year term. After completing the prescribed requirements, committee members may serve as Breed Presenters or Breed Mentors.

### **Committee Membership Qualifications:**

- Member in good standing of the ETSCA
- In good standing with the AKC
- Documented experience of at least 10 years involvement in conformation events with the breed
- Ability to effectively communicate with others
- Willingness to actively participate and team with others to develop and update relevant content
