A junior member may apply for Regular Membership after a minimum of one year of membership and having attained the age of 18 years. Junior Member applicants must also provide a brief statement from an adult (not the applicant's parent) supporting their application. Junior Membership applicants will be approved by the majority vote of the English Toy Spaniel Board of Directors and Officers.
